## **Healthy school snacks**

Please ensure children's morning snacks are not chocolate or crisps. We recommend fruit. We have had lots of children bringing in crisps etc this week. From Monday, we won't be allowing children to eat crisps at break as is the case in all schools.

## **Jewellery and hair**

As is the case in every school I know of, no jewellery is allowed other than stud earrings. This is for safety reasons. Children are allowed to wear watches, but smart watches are not allowed due to e-safety rules. Hair should be tied up if possible and be above shoulder length if not. This is to reduce the risk of headlice.

## **PE kit**

Please ensure children come to school on PE days wearing Littletown school uniform PE kit. Children are only allowed to wear other sports wear on non-uniform days.

## **Attendance**

It was so lovely to see the children return to school on Wednesday with an excited post Christmas buzz. Well done to all of you for ensuring your children arrived on time, no children were signed in late- a fantastic start to the New Year! Please may I take this opportunity to remind you of the continued expectations for school attendance:

The school day starts at 8.50am, any pupils arriving 8.55am onwards must be signed in by a parent /carer.

Please ensure you contact the school before the start of the school day if your child is going to be absent and the reason why.

School will ask to see appointment letters for medical/hospital appointments, these will be authorised for the time of the appointment.

Holidays will not be authorised, unless they are deemed to be exceptional circumstances. Unauthorised holidays will continue to be referred to Devon County Council.

School monitors attendance daily and will make contact with you via phone or letter if your child's attendance is below 90% (persistence absence) or if your child is repeatedly late.

Devon County Attendance Officers now visit schools termly to discuss pupils who fall into absent categories.

We are committed to working with you and supporting you to ensure your child attends school in line with both our attendance and safeguarding policies. Please do not hesitate to contact us for further information or support.
