Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to start by thanking the PTFA for another great couple of discos last Friday. It is always fantastic to see the children having such a great time.

We have had an exceptionally busy week this week - even for us! It has been hard to keep track of which children are doing what and where on some days! On Tuesday, some of our children visited St Luke's in Exeter to take part in a Boccia competition and Year 2 and Year 5 enjoyed a fire safety talk from the Fire Education team. Year 4 have had the second swimming session at Honiton Leisure Centre. On Wednesday 7 Year 6 children represented the school at the Year 6 Youth Speak competition at Honiton Community College where they spoke brilliantly to an audience of around 75 people. Yesterday we had children attending the Exeter City Football Tournament where they represented themselves really well and other KS2 children attending a workshop event at Honiton Bowling Club. Today, Year 3 visited Kent's Cavern and some Y5 and 6 boys took part in the boys Futsal competition at Honiton Leisure Centre. Following all of these trips and visits I have received comments about how well the children behaved. My thanks to all the staff and parents who have accompanied children this week!

In our whole school assembly today, I quizzed the children on their knowledge of our school values (Live, Love, Learn), school rules (Ready, Respectful, Safe), British Values (democracy, tolerance, respect, liberty and rule of law) and our learning principles on our learning rocket (fun lessons, expert teachers, great things to use, goldilocks zone and growth mindset). I was really impressed with how well the children could speak about these. Why not ask your children about them over the weekend so you can be just as impressed!

Next week is a bit quieter, with outdoor classrooms for 2AL Tuesday, Nursery Wednesday and 2CL/DB on Thursday. On Tuesday some of our children take part in after school TAG Rugby and on Wednesday it is our KS1 celebration Assembly so if the children have any medals or trophies or other achievements they would like to share please bring them in.
