Nursery This week, Nursery have been making magic glitter potions in the garden. They also have been using different tools to squish playdough with.

Reception They pretended to be authors and made some books about animals. They used grown up words in Maths like subtraction. They also made a poster of their favourite animals.

Year 1 In History they have been learning about the Great Fire of London. In Art, they have been learning about mixing primary and secondary colours.
